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5	Recreational facilities	To enhance recreational facilities to student, an additional canteen is going to be functional from next academic session in the upper campus.
6	Need of more teachers in some department	Government already apprised regarding the need of more teachers in some departments and three Guest Lecturers has been appointed for smooth functioning of classes for the 2021-22 session.
7	Relevance of syllabus	New UGC prescribed CBCS system has been introduced in UG courses (all the three streams viz. arts, science, and commerce). CBCS is already in place for PG courses.
8	Upgradation of laboratories	Planning to upgrade laboratories with new equipment.
9	Need of more value-added courses.	New value-added short-term courses on soft skills, personality development and communication skills etc will be introduced in the coming session.
10	Class timing to be made compact.	Routine committee already apprised to make class timing compact. However, due to CBCS and non-CBCS courses the present class timings can not be made more compact.
11	Requirement of more Xerox facility	The Xerox facility of the Library has been upgraded for the benefit of the students. Some departments/Cells have also been provided with machines.



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
