
STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY 2023-2024



















15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. 230 responses









18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.


